

OUT OF STATE TRANSFERS AND THE PROVISION OF SPECIAL EDUCATION AND RELATED SERVICES FLOW CHART

If a child with a disability, who had an IEP that was in effect in a school in another state, transfers to a school in a new state, and enrolls in a new school within the same school year, the school must provide the child with a FAPE including services comparable to those described in the child’s IEP from the previous school, until the new school conducts an evaluation (if determined to be necessary by the receiving school) and develops, adopts, and implements a new IEP, if appropriate (34 C.F.R. 300.323 MDE).
